Student Feedback Report – Govt. P.G. College New Tehri for the academic session 2022-23 & Action Taken

This report summarizes student feedback on the syllabus, teaching & learning methods, and extracurricular activities for the students of all the courses. The feedback was collected through a survey distributed to all students enrolled in the course through google form.

Students generally agreed that the syllabus is clearly outlined, good choice of elective courses with well-defined course objectives are given. Feedback indicates that the listed readings and resources were helpful and equally available in the library. Students are enthusiastic for the remedial classes and almost 90% respondents wished to continue the same in the coming sessions

Students who have responded to the survey are regular in the classes (64%), participated in various co-curricular activities such as Sports, cultural, student union election etc. With respect to their classroom studies, they found the instructor's explanations clear, the instructor fostered classroom participation and discussion in a very courteous manner, the chosen teaching methods were effective for learning, around 70-80% syllabus is covered in the classroom through various modes.

When asked about examination patterns, they prefer objective and subjective patterns equally, although few are happy with the assignment only. Majority of the chunk feels that the Internal method of evaluation is fair, timely shared and discussed in the classroom and if anything needed is advised by the instructor on due time as shown by majority of the respondents, i.e., 66% and it helps them in further improvement as 80% respondents said.

Students valued timely and constructive feedback on assignments, students found assessments fair and reflective of the material. In response to the available physical facilities, administrative support, and outside visits, they have submitted varying responses from good to satisfactory.

IQAC recommendations: As a college we need to understand which teaching methods were particularly helpful or unhelpful for the students. Our students are coming from far rural area, so we need hostel facilities and transportation facilities within the city especially for girls. For much more involvement we need to encourage scheduled sports, cultural activities and proper

field tours for students, this will enhance the student enrolment as well as health and interactive environment in college premises.

Faculty Feedback Report – Govt. P.G. College New Tehri for the academic session 2022-23

This report summarizes the feedback received from faculty members of GPGC New Tehri, for the academic session 2022-23. The feedback was collected through google surveys and focused on various aspects of teaching, learning, administrative and departmental support.

Key Areas of Feedback:

• Curriculum:

- o **Strengths:** More than 80% of the faculty generally agreed that the curriculum content is relevant and up-to-date, a good balance between theory and its applicability, followed by relevant reference reading in most courses.
- o **Areas for Improvement:** Some faculty members suggested incorporating more active learning strategies and opportunities for real-world application.

• Teaching and Learning:

- o **Strengths:** Faculty reported feeling well-supported by instructional technology resources and appreciated the freedom to invite professionals from different fields to deliver lectures, their experiences and interactions among resource persons. They feel benefitted by official leave for attending development workshops, seminars or conferences etc.
- o **Areas for Improvement:** A few faculty members requested special funds for conducting exposure tours to facilitate more student centric approach and attention.

• Departmental/ College Support:

- o **Strengths:** Faculty expressed satisfaction with the level of communication and collaboration, participation in decision making regarding various aspects such as procurement of resources (books, laboratory equipment or any other related resource is well addressed). Most of the departments are satisfied with the recently available physical facilities within their departments and in college. It has been found that, there are no such grievances in the college, but if reported, are amicably resolved at the earliest
- o **Areas for Improvement:** Majority among the faculties suggested that while preparing the new curriculum BOS should invite ideas from industry people, so that a futuristic approach can be introduced well in advance. Some faculty suggested streamlining administrative processes to follow the prescribed academic calendar, reduce administrative workload, so that they can contribute in research activities, within and outside the department.

• Student Engagement:

- o **Strengths:** Faculty noted satisfaction about students' participation in extracurricular activities, classroom performance, discipline and online discussion forums.
- o **Areas for Improvement:** A few faculty members expressed concern about a lack of critical thinking skills demonstrated by some students.

Conclusion: Several faculty members commented on the positive impact of recent initiatives such as the new student mentoring program.

The overall feedback from faculty members is positive. They appreciate the college's commitment to providing quality education and are actively engaged in continuous improvement efforts. The areas for improvement identified in this report will be addressed through further discussions, workshops, and resource allocation.

IQAC Recommendations:

Summarized copy of the feedback will be discussed with the competent authority, i.e. head of the institution for **further action**. **Afterwards** a detailed report with specific action items will be prepared based on the feedback. Faculty development workshops as per the NEP syllabus will be offered to address identified needs in areas like active learning strategies and online teaching methods. A college-wide committee will be formed to explore options for streamlining administrative processes.

Feedback received from the Non-Teaching Staff Govt. P.G. College New Tehri For the Academic Session 2022-23 (Analysis and Interpretation)

The 'non-teaching' staff comprising 47 positions, includes all the staff appointed towards the support of the 'task of teaching and the teaching faculty' and the maintenance of the institution such as the office, the library, labs, multitasking 4th class and the cleaning staff. These consist of a variety of positions, job status and quite varying methods of appointments. As the diagrams show, the majority of the office staff consists of contractual, *UPNAL* (Uttarakhand Purva-Sainik Kalyan Nigam Ltd.) and temporary appointments. Factual understanding of the data projected onto the diagrams can only be meaningful if this variety is kept in focus.

Qualifications of such staff vary from minimum 8th standard to the Master's degree. So far, the gender composition is concerned the staff structure is somewhat balanced and equally represented by either.

As far as the caste constitution of the staff is concerned, all the categories such as the General, SC, and OBC are represented as shown by the diagrams barring the scheduled tribes.

It's heartening to find that close to 90% of the staff has responded that they find it very much comfortable working at the institution. However, 11% respond that it is OK working here. Very few that are only 1% report that they find the work challenging and sometimes difficult, otherwise the majority report that 'only sometimes' they feel the difficulty. None of the staff has faced any instance of bad behavior from the colleagues and the teaching faculty. Generally, it is maintained that there is an amiable atmosphere in the institution. The diagrams show that only ¼ of the entire staff point out that they sometimes face discriminatory behavior in the institution in relation to the position, otherwise the rest report that the behavior of the people in the institution is good.

The staff accepts that they have been given appropriate directions for their job obligations. Majority of the staff admits that they are fully aware and understand their job profile well and in entirety is hopeful of upgrading their skills and qualifications. Only few, who are appointed for short term temporary placements have any doubts and non-clarity about it. While, 60% of the staff feels that the present mechanism is adequate for addressing their grievances, 40% feel a better mechanism is required in this regard. 85% admit that they have either no awareness of the Financial Handbook or only a partial understanding of it, whereas, the rest agree that they have read the entire relevant portions of it.

As regards the library, only 20% of the staff claims to have a practical understanding of library management tasks while the rest have no understanding of it.
