Title of the Practice: Response of faculty during an unforeseen emergency

Objective of the Practice: The objective of the practice is to keep the objectives of teaching and learning intact during the pandemic induced lockdown. The practice aimed at avoiding any break in the process of teaching and learning by resorting to online teaching during the lockdown.

Problems encountered and Resource Required: Inaccessible technology in remote areas, network issues, inappropriate devices with the students were some of the problems encountered in the practice.

Notes: Massive transfer of teachers also became a hindrance.
