

GOVERNMENT PG COLLEGE, NEW TEHRI STUDENT SATISFACTORY SURVEY: 2018-19

The first questionnaire-based student satisfaction survey was conducted in the college by IQAC. Total 50 students from different disciplines participated in the survey. Majority of the respondents who completed the survey were in the 20-22 years age group who were pursuing their UG and PG from faculty of Sciences and Commerce.

This survey was intended to collect, various aspects such as student's perception towards the college, teaching and learning environment in the college, student-teacher relationship in the learning process, level of satisfaction among the learners and suggestion (if any) for the improvement of the current status of the college.

Responses of survey were analyzed by using statistical tools. It has been observed that maximum (more than 80%) syllabus was covered, and teachers were thoroughly prepared with effective communication skills and adequate pedagogical approach.

Students were truly satisfied and happy with the internal examination and evaluation pattern and other aspects such as classroom discussions, illustration and quality improvement etc.

Maximum teachers were equipped with ICT tools and utilized it for their classes. Among the respondents more than 25% strongly convinced about the overall quality of teaching and learning atmosphere in the college whereas few were neutral about their opinion.

Suggestions by respondent were also recorded. Some of the highlights from the responses are as follows:

Hindi medium books were in demand

Needs more furnished classrooms.

Digital library

Canteen facilities

Books covering entire syllabus.

NCC facility in college.

The IQAC of the college will put forth the above outcomes of the survey in the upcoming meeting for discussion and further analysis and improvement.

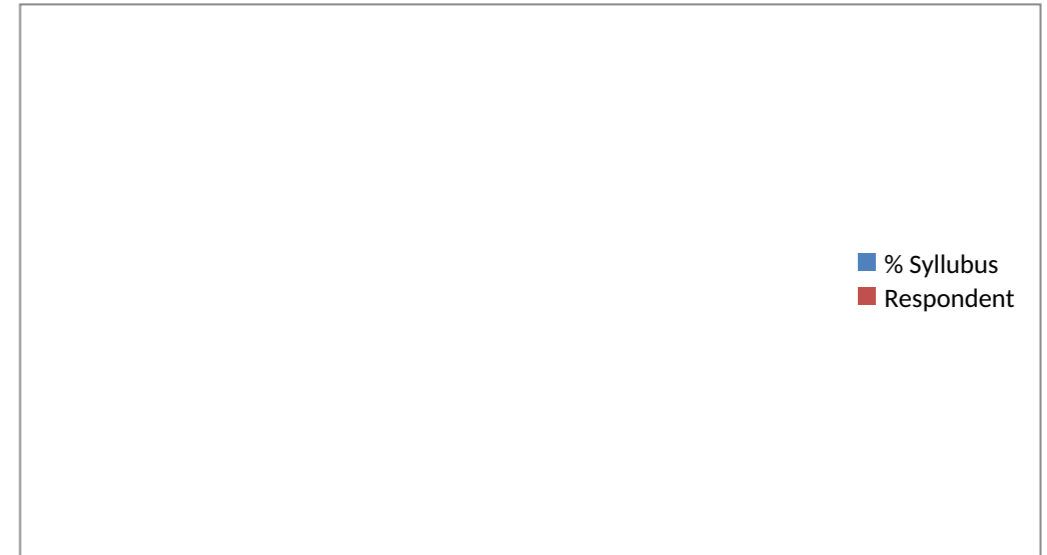
Recommendations and Advisory by the IQAC
